## Choosing an OB/GYN is Personal

“Pregnancy is generally the most exciting time for you and your spouse/partner. You should thoroughly enjoy it from the time you get a positive home pregnancy test until the day of your delivery. Generally most doctors like to see you for your first visit between 6 1/2 to 9 weeks from the time of your last menstrual period. Before 6 weeks very little can be determined as to the status of the pregnancy and it may cause unnecessary anxiety. By 6 to 7 weeks we can usually determine if the pregnancy is in the uterus and if there is a viable fetus present. That is when the fun begins! Your doctor and his/her staff will take you on a journey of testing and routine procedures, all of which optimize the well being of your baby. Birthing classes are also offered through our office and are quite helpful to alleviate any anxiety associated with labor and delivery. Your experience with proper preparation will hopefully live up to and exceed expectations”.
